## ANIMATIBA EM TEMPOS DE PANDEMIA

Nosso segundo evento deveria ocorrer de forma presencial, com exibições em salas de cinema, palestras e encontros em auditórios, conversas em cafés, todavia a pandemia Covid-19 mudou o cotidiano de todos nós, de forma que precisamos buscar soluções e nos adaptar ao momento. A primeira medida que tomamos foi postergar o evento. O ANIMATIBA 2 deveria ocorrer em 2020, mas houvemos por bem adiá-lo para 2021, acreditando no fim da situação pandêmica. Infelizmente, nos primeiros meses de 2021 a vacinação no Brasil ainda andava a passos lentos e as limitações para encontros sociais se mantinham, principalmente em recintos fechados. Dessa forma, decidimos transformar nosso evento em um encontro digital, com a exibição dos filmes através de uma plataforma de exibição por streaming. Assim, solicitamos mudanças em nosso projeto junto à Fundação Cultural de Curitiba e a Comissão Municipal de Incentivo à Cultura teve a sensibilidade e sabedoria para compreensão de nosso pleito, aprovando-o totalmente. Assim, avançamos nessa direção.

Todavia, a migração de formato não foi fácil. Após uma grande pesquisa técnica e econômica das soluções existentes no mercado (nacionais e internacionais), resolvemos apostar no talento local, contratando o cientista da computação Guilmour Rossi e sua equipe, cuja experiência no projeto Libreflix o qualificava tanto tecnicamente quanto espiritualmente para o desafio. Outro parceiro importante foi Piatã Muller que, com a equipe da I9, nos ajudou no gerenciamento da plataforma e nas estratégias de atração de público. Assim, após alguns meses de trabalho, colocamos no ar o ANIMATIBA PLAY ([play.animatiba.com.br](http://play.animatiba.com.br)), nossa exclusiva plataforma de exibição dos filmes.



Outro desafio enfrentado nesta edição foi o quantitativo de filmes. Ao abrirmos a inscrição para seleção, o mundo nos deu uma grata surpresa na medida em que recebemos exatamente 1568 inscrições de uma centena de países. A imagem anterior mostra as regiões que enviaram filmes para a seleção (o escurecimento do azul significa maior quantidade) e indica os países que mais se destacaram, entre os quais nominamos Brasil, Estados Unidos da América, França, Irã, Índia, Reino Unido, Itália, Argentina, Espanha, Rússia e Portugal como aqueles que enviaram mais de quarenta inscrições cada. Esse quantitativo de filmes tornou a seleção muito complexa, mas nos legou uma seleção riquíssima. Ótimos filmes ficaram fora dessa seleção pois precisávamos estabelecer um número viável para nossa estrutura, de forma a darmos conta da comunicação com os realizadores, do recebimento dos filmes, organização, alinhamento técnico das obras, tradução e legendagem, adaptação à plataforma, uploads, testes, backups, etc. Para a seleção, estabelecemos como critérios a escolha das melhores obras em termos estilísticos e narrativos, buscando diversidade de gêneros, estéticas, temas, abordagens e origens geográficas.

Neste novo formato, mantivemos os encontros profissionais e, graças à tecnologia da informação, pudemos transformar um problema – a pandemia – na oportunidade para lives com profissionais de várias cidades do Brasil, como também da Indonésia, Portugal, Coreia do Sul, Chile, Argentina, Noruega, Hungria, Índia e Venezuela.

Neste ano ampliamos a comissão julgadora, convidando colegas de São Paulo (Ricardo Romin e Rosana Urbes), Rio de Janeiro (Valu Vasconcelos), Curitiba (Elis Lobo) e Seul (Hong Suk Hwa), os quais testemunharam a grande dificuldade em escolher as melhores obras entre tantas excelentes.

Mantivemos o mesmo troféu, o mesmo entusiasmo e o mesmo amor pela arte da animação. Mantivemos também a prática de convidar um artista curitibano para fazer o trailer de abertura do evento. Assim, através do olhar de Fernando Macedo (Spirit) tivemos a sorte mostrar nossa cidade para o mundo, num filme em que Curitiba se torna palco de personagens de séries animadas internacionais criadas e produzidas aqui, como Carlos (Spirit Animation), Brichos (Tecnokena), Planetorama (Cabong Studios) e Carrapatos e Catapultas (Zoom Elefante).

Se, por um lado, o mundo vive grandes tensões políticas, crises sanitárias, econômicas e ambientais, podemos afiançar que nosso evento é um momento especial de encontro de nacionalidades, sensibilidades e reflexões, todas muito positivas, na busca da construção de um mundo melhor para todos nós. Talvez essa seja a grande missão da arte: aproximar os povos.

ANIMATIBA significa MUITA ALMA, como também significa ANIMAÇÃO em CURITIBA. Dessa forma, manifestamos nossa grande honra em poder espalhar pelo mundo, a partir de nossa cidade, enunciados tão belos e tão fortes, em imagens e sons muito bem animados.

## ANIMATIBA IN TIMES OF PANDEMIC

Our second event should take place in person, with screenings in movie theaters, lectures and meetings in auditoriums, conversations in cafes, however the Covid-19 pandemic changed the daily lives of all of us, so we need to seek solutions and adapt to the moment. The first step we took was to postpone the event. ANIMATIBA 2 was supposed to take place in 2020, but we decided to postpone it to 2021, believing in the end of the pandemic situation. Unfortunately, in the first months of 2021 vaccination in Brazil was still at a slow pace and the limitations for social gatherings remained, especially indoors. Thus, we decided to transform our event into a digital meeting, with the exhibition of films through a streaming exhibition platform. Thus, we requested changes in our project to the Fundação Cultural de Curitiba and Comissão de Cultura, who had the sensitivity and wisdom to understand our claim, fully approving it. So, we move in that direction.

However, format migration was not easy. After extensive technical and economic research of existing solutions on the market (national and international), we decided to bet on local talent, hiring computer scientist Guilmour Rossi and his team, whose experience in the Libreflix project qualified him both technically and spiritually for the challenge. Another important partner was Piatã Muller, who, with the I9 team, helped us with the platform management and public attraction strategies. So, after a few months of work, we launched ANIMATIBA PLAY ([play.animatiba.com.br](http://play.animatiba.com.br)), our exclusive platform for showing the films.



Another challenge faced in this edition was the quantity of films. When we opened the application for selection, the world gave us a pleasant surprise as we received exactly 1568 entries from a hundred countries. The image above shows the regions that sent films for the selection (the darkening of the blue means more) and indicates the countries that stood out the most, among which we named Brazil, United States of America, France, Iran, India, United Kingdom, Italy, Argentina, Spain, Russia and Portugal as those who sent more than forty entries each. This quantity of films made the selection very complex, but left us a very rich selection. Great films were out of this selection because we needed to establish a viable number for our structure, in order to handle communication with the filmmakers, receiving films, organization, technical alignment of works, translation and subtitling, adaptation to the platform, uploads, tests, backups, etc. For the selection, we established as criteria the choice of the best works in stylistic and narrative terms, seeking a diversity of genres, aesthetics, themes, approaches and geographical origins.

In this new format, we kept professional meetings and, thanks to information technology, we were able to transform a problem – the pandemic – into the opportunity for lives with professionals from several cities in Brazil, as well as from Indonesia, Portugal, South Korea, Chile, Argentina, Norway, Hungary, India and Venezuela.

This year we expanded the judging commission, inviting colleagues from São Paulo (Ricardo Romin and Rosana Urbes), Rio de Janeiro (Valu Vasconcelos), Curitiba (Elis Lobo) and Seoul (Hong Suk Hwa), who witnessed the great difficulty in choosing the best works among so many excellent ones. We kept the same trophy, the same enthusiasm and the same love for the art of animation. We also maintained the practice of inviting an artist from Curitiba to make the event's opening trailer. Thus, through the eyes of Fernando Macedo (Spirit) we were lucky to show our city to the world, in a film in which Curitiba becomes the stage for characters from international animated series created and produced here, such as Carlos (Spirit Animation), Brichos (Tecnokena), Planetorama (Cabong Studios) and Ticks and Catapults (Elefante Zoom).

If, on the one hand, the world is experiencing great political tensions, sanitary, economic and environmental crises, we can assure you that our event is a special moment for the meeting of nationalities, sensibilities and reflections, all very positive, in the quest to build a better world for all of us. Perhaps this is the great mission of art: bringing people together.

ANIMATIBA means A LOT of SOUL, as it also means ANIMATION in CURITIBA. Thus, we express our great honor in being able to spread throughout the world, from our city, such beautiful and strong utterances, in very animated images and sounds.

## **DIÁLOGOS CONVERGENTES**

### **DIÁLOGOS CONVERGENTES I**

O “olho” do Animatiba encontra ressonância em alguns curtas selecionados para o Festival. O curta “Sonhos”, de Douglas Alves Ferreira, traz uma narrativa reflexiva sobre a vida e a morte, tendo o olho como um dos signos emblemáticos de sua construção e montagem, pulsando, refletindo a alma, nos olhando e dando vida aos poemas de William Blake e Thomas Hardy. O curta “Contrastes”, de Jackson Abacatu, exibe olhos, mas em sentido mais literal, ou seja, olhos que podem ver contrastes e impressões da cultura de Israel. A forma dos olhos está também no globo terrestre, na janela do avião, mas essencialmente nos olhos dos seres humanos e animais, que podem ver a cidade destruída, os conflitos e protestos, a calmaria e o caos. O curta “Anodic Hit”, de Zhouye Sun, nos traz uma forma de olho metafórico que vê outras formas geométricas.

Outro curta que cria um diálogo com o olho do Animatiba é o “Poética de barro” (Giuliana Danza) que, como o título já prenuncia, oferece uma narrativa poética e metafórica com ícones de argila, imóveis, baseados nos trabalhos de ceramistas mineiros do Vale das Viúvas de Maridos Vivos, em Jequitinhonha, Minas Gerais. Porém, há uma exceção, um ser que se move e percorre outros caminhos desafiando e tendo novas experiências, sendo uma homenagem à expansão do infinito e da radiosa luz. O curta “Poética de barro” conversa também com outro curta, “Alma”, de Rola Hafez, que revela robôs que seguem uma rotina extenuante. Um entre os robôs, porém, a exemplo do desbravador em “Poética de barro”, questiona seu status e revela sua alma ao se aproximar de uma flor, que também tem um tipo de olho amarelo em seu centro. O título “Alma” dialoga também com “anima”, palavra latina que significa “alma”, assim como Animatiba, animação com muita alma.

## DIÁLOGOS CONVERGENTES II

Quatro curtas desenvolvem o tema da liberdade de voar e sonhar em maneiras diversas, com algumas convergências. “You can fly”, de Sung Bae Park, narra com sensibilidade a trajetória de uma águia que adota um pequeno pinguim que quer voar e sente que deve proteger seu filho adotivo. O curta, sem palavras, tem imagens significativas que suscitam o conceito de pai e suas atitudes generosas: um pássaro que aprende a ser pai e um filho que aprende suas limitações. Em “Wrinkled”, de Goran Dimov, um avô ensina seu neto a dobrar papel. O curta é metafórico, feito com origamis que iniciam com um avião em vôo, se transformam em barco, evocam uma lenda que diz que 1.000 guindastes de papel concedem um desejo. O neto tenta dobrar seus papéis, mas estão enrugados e então surge uma nova idéia: 1.000 lanternas para iluminar o céu à noite como uma maneira de fazer o papel voar como um foguete, simbolizando o aprendizado do neto. Enquanto em “You can fly” o “voar” é literal, sendo um desejo do pingüim que deve perceber a impossibilidade de seu sonho e aceitar “voar” sendo carregado pelo seu pai adotivo, em “Wrinkled” é o avô quem dirige o aprendizado do “voar”, já não sendo em sentido literal. Em “Dubicel”, de Yashira Jordan, há um menino que sonha com janelas imaginárias que permitirão um vôo no universo celeste até o momento em que um pássaro o carrega para um vôo, em um momento de intertextualidade (Kristeva) com a águia que carrega o pinguim e o faz voar. Quando o pássaro consegue abrir uma janela, o menino pode contemplar com seu telescópio o que sempre quis fazer: ver constelações para imaginar suas ligações e suas vidas secretas. Em “The Last Day”, de Dalibor Rajninger, o “voar” atinge um sentido figurativo extremo, no sentido do tempo que voa para uma personagem que lembra o passado e quer agarrar o tempo presente que está terminando para ela. O tempo é, no curta, representado por um pássaro que foge da gaiola diversas vezes, sendo capturado pela protagonista até que não há mais o que esta possa fazer a não ser se entregar junto à última folha que cai da árvore. E assim os quatro curtas convergem em relação ao sentido de “voar” como parte de um sonho, que começa literalmente quando o pequeno pinguim quer voar, no curta ‘You can fly’, passa pelo vôo do origami no curta “Wrinkled”, pelo “voar” imaginário do protagonista-menino no “Dubicel” e termina seu percurso intertextual no curta “The Last Day”.

### Diálogos Convergentes III

Há certos curtas com montagens que desafiam o espectador, fazendo com que o mesmo tenha que ser participador ou até interator. Em “Um dia frio”, de Victor Percy, um detetive é o protagonista com papel duplo e ambíguo, o que força o espectador a construir hipóteses como a de que o detetive está sonhando sentado em sua cadeira na frente de sua lareira ou relembrando ou pensando o que gostaria de ter feito, ou ainda outras hipóteses que conduzam a possíveis leituras para o entendimento da trama. Outro curta que depende do espectador é “Chatter” (Max Kozik), onde o protagonista é um jovem que procura entender os discursos infundáveis de seus colegas até que encontra uma jovem surda muda que chama sua atenção e que exige dele um esforço para escrever e se adaptar ao seu mundo silencioso. Após acertos e desacertos, ambos continuam concentrados em se fazerem entender. Sempre contando com um espectador que compartilhe dos desafios apresentados, o curta “Chatter” dialoga com o “Les chaussures de Louis” (Théo Jamin), que exige que o espectador conheça o mundo de um autista ajudado pela sua professora que, para que o aluno tenha interação com a turma, pede que esta compartilhe do entendimento que o autista apresenta. Usando sapatos como metonímias, o curta é reflexivo, exibindo, em poucos minutos, uma visão da vida diferenciada do autismo, assim como a vida diferenciada dos surdos mudos. O curta “One night stand”, de Azalia Muchransyah, requer um repertório intercultural. O espectador deve compreender que a palavra ‘nightstand’ em inglês tem duplo sentido, é a mesinha de cabeceira assim como é o relacionamento de uma noite. A mesinha de cabeceira é o narrador do curta, que conta as aventuras de seu dono em suas nightstands e que sugere mudanças de comportamento, atuando no sonho bem sucedido. Caso o espectador não entenda o jogo com a palavra, o curta perde parte de sua relevância, apesar de sua construção artística. Em relação ao espectador, o curta que mais prende a atenção e mais exige sua concentração é “Dormo poco e sogno molto” (Paolo Santamaría), um plano sequencia veloz, com trilha sonora que acompanha o movimento dos celulares e tablets que se deslocam conduzindo o olhar do espectador, que deve também ler as legendas, caso não entenda italiano. O curta é um exercício de observação atenta para captar em quatro minutos todo um modo de vida não tradicional, descrito de maneira inovadora, desenhando uma filosofia de viagem. O espectador neste caso deve ser um interator que possa compartilhar e entender a ideia do protagonista. Nos cinco curtas, aqui colocados em diálogos convergentes, podemos notar que o espectador, deixando de ser passivo, deve ficar cada

vez mais ativo até chegar ao último, que é um verdadeiro desafio tanto na montagem quanto na velocidade, na trilha sonora e na ideia condutora.

## DIÁLOGOS CONVERGENTES IV

Há quatro curtas que convergem no tema da depressão. A protagonista de "Mother didn't know", curta de Anita Killi, recebe ajuda de um personagem de contos de fadas para sair do lugar metafórico em que se encontra, isolada como se estivesse em um poço profundo. Quando vê um pássaro que precisa de sua ajuda, sai de seu isolamento e, ao vê-lo voando, com vida, resolve também, como em uma fábula, voltar à sua vida, chamando por sua mãe. Com estética impressionista para retratar o niilismo da personagem, o curta "Down", de Gabriella Muresán, conversa com o curta de Anita Killi, no sentido da trajetória da protagonista, que chega ao fundo de seu eu, atormentada pela sua falta de reação, aceitando ser sem valor, até o momento em que resolve reagir à depressão sozinha, lutando para se tornar livre de sua apatia. Curta "Wot If", de Monami Roy, inspirado no poema "what if", de Shel Silverstein, descreve a trajetória de uma menina com problema de ansiedade, que se pergunta "wot if", ou seja what if – que tal se estou sendo recusada por todos, que tal se meus pais me abandonarem e meus colegas ficarem rindo de mim e não me aceitarem, até o momento em que decide enfrentar seus desafios e se tornar forte para sobreviver aos seus medos em diálogo com o curta "Down". O curta de Valeria Rodriguez "Liebenstraum", começa nietzschiniano, em tom sombrio, com personagem que, ao contrário da menina protagonista que sai da depressão para salvar o pássaro, não chama uma ambulância ao ferido e coloca mais uma data em sua carta de suicida, contemplando seu revólver. Porém, ao adormecer, suas lembranças se referem ao livre arbítrio mencionado por sua mãe, e aos que decidem machucar outros e as imagens que se seguem são de guerras, bombas e mortes, até o momento em que sua lembrança evoca sua mãe novamente, quando a mesma diz que o livre arbítrio pode criar arte e as imagens se sucedem, ao som da trilha sonora de Liebenstraum no. 3 de Franz Liszt. Inspirado em "El sueño de un hombre ridículo" de Fiódor Dostoyevski, o curta desenvolve um diálogo com a imagem da mãe, evocada pela menina do primeiro curta desta parte dos diálogos convergentes e também pelo personagem deste curta, seguindo um trajeto que une inicio e fim desta análise circular.

## DIÁLOGOS CONVERGENTES V

Esta série de 3 curtas apresenta um tema convergente: desejos. Contudo, os pontos de vista e perspectivas diferem. Em “The dead hands of Dublin”, de Leo Crowley, o pianista protagonista projeta sua fama e seu poder no uso de luvas mágicas que o fazem executar trechos clássicos com maestria. Porém, no decorrer do tempo, seus desejos de grandeza o levam a exercer sua tirania. O curta evoca o fascínio pela fama que faz com que boas intenções levem a caminhos tortuosos. O desejo da protagonista de “Web”, por outro lado, é sair da Internet. O curta dialoga com as pesquisas de Sherry Turkle, quando esta se fascina pelas redes sociais em seus primeiros textos, mas aos poucos percebe que a multidão é dispersiva. Seu livro *Alone Together* pode ser adaptado para dialogar com a protagonista quando esta só tem um desejo: sair da rede. “Kiwi’s Dream”, de Paloma Zhu, expressa o desejo de animais feitos de origami que querem sair de seus lugares, querem ser reais, querem interagir, voar e viver, situações impossíveis de serem realizadas, e que dialogam com o curta “Mama”, onde um menino deseja ter sua falecida mãe de volta. Seu pai diz que ela está em uma estrela e ele vai a uma loja de mágica, adquire um laço e traz sua estrela para sua cabeceira. Nos dois curtas, os desejos são impossíveis. O desejo do protagonista do curta de Ralph Khoury, “I want to leave”, é de esperança e desesperança, é um desejo de mudança radical, quase que pedindo por um milagre, por uma vida com outros objetivos, com paz. A estética é minimalista, a montagem vacila como um pêndulo, ora revelando a vontade do protagonista em mudar, ora retornando à rotina do status quo. Um curta que consegue, em poucos minutos, contemplar facetas profundas e complexas que frustram expectativas de mudanças.

Para encerrar estes Diálogos Convergentes, cito o curta “Animators for Belarus/ Long live Belarus”, de 50 animadores de 19 países, de estética geométrica com ênfase em faixa vermelha onde há pássaros em seus voos, tanques de guerra, olhos que choram, flores que pedem a paz e, relevante para nosso ANIMATIBA, uma lagartixa que desenha um coração pulsante.

## **CONVERGIN DIALOGUESS**

### **CONVERGING DIALOGUES I**

Animatiba's "eye" finds resonance in some short films selected for the Festival. The short film "Sonhos", by Douglas Alves Ferreira, brings a reflective narrative about life and death, with the eye as one of the emblematic signs of its construction and montage, pulsating, reflecting the soul, looking at us and giving life to the poems of William Blake and Thomas Hardy. The short film "Contrastes", by Jackson Abacatu, shows eyes, but in a more literal sense, that is, eyes that can see contrasts and impressions of the culture of Israel. The shape of the eyes is also on the globe, in the airplane window, but essentially in the eyes of human beings and animals, who can see the destroyed city, conflicts and protests, calm and chaos. The short "Anodic Hit", by Zhouye Sun, brings us a metaphorical eye shape that sees other geometric shapes. Another short film that creates a dialogue with Animatiba's eye is "Poética de barro" (Giuliana Danza), which, as the title already foreshadows, offers a poetic and metaphorical narrative with immobile clay icons based on the work of ceramists from Minas Gerais. Valley of the Widows of Husbands Vivos, in Jequitinhonha, Minas Gerais. However, there is an exception, a being that moves and walks along other paths challenging and having new experiences, paying homage to the expansion of the infinite and the radiant light. The short "Poética de barro" also talks with another short, "Alma", by Rola Hafez, which reveals robots that follow a strenuous routine. One among the robots, however, like the pathfinder in "Poetics of clay", questions his status and reveals his soul when approaching a flower, which also has a kind of yellow eye in its center. The title "Soul" also dialogues with "anima", a Latin word that means "soul", as well as Animatiba, animation with a lot of soul.

## CONVERGING DIALOGUES II

Four short films develop the theme of freedom to fly and dream in different ways, with some convergences. "You Can Fly", by Sung Bae Park, sensitively narrates the trajectory of an eagle that adopts a small penguin that wants to fly and feels that he must protect his adopted son. The short, without words, has significant images that raise the concept of father and his generous attitudes: a bird that learns to be a father and a son that learns its limitations. In Goran Dimov's "Wrinkled," a grandfather teaches his grandson to fold paper. The short is metaphorical, made with origamis that start with an airplane in flight, transform into a boat, evoking a legend that says that 1,000 paper cranes grant a wish. The grandson tries to fold his papers, but they are wrinkled and then a new idea comes up: 1,000 lanterns to light up the sky at night as a way to make the paper fly like a rocket, symbolizing the grandson's learning. While in "You can fly" the "fly" is literal, being a penguin's desire that must realize the impossibility of his dream and accept "flying" being carried by his adoptive father, in "Wrinkled" it is the grandfather who directs the learning process of "flying", no longer being in a literal sense. In "Dubicel", by Yashira Jordan, there is a boy who dreams of imaginary windows that will allow him to fly in the celestial universe until the moment when a bird carries him for a flight, in a moment of intertextuality (Kristeva) with the eagle that carries him. the penguin and makes him fly. When the bird manages to open a window, the boy can contemplate with his telescope what he always wanted to do: see constellations to imagine their connections and their secret lives. In "The Last Day", by Dalibor Rajninger, "flying" reaches an extreme figurative sense, in the sense of time that flies for a character who remembers the past and wants to grasp the present time that is ending for her. Time is, in the short, represented by a bird that escapes from the cage several times, being captured by the protagonist until there is nothing more that she can do but surrender to the last leaf that falls from the tree. And so the four short films converge in the sense of "flying" as part of a dream, which literally starts when the little penguin wants to fly, in the short 'You can fly', through the flight of origami in the short 'Wrinkled', through imaginary "voar" of the boy-protagonist in "Dubicel" and ends his intertextual journey in the short "The Last Day".

### Convergent Dialogues III

There are certain shorts with montages that challenge the viewer, making them have to be a participant or even an interactor. In Victor Percy's "A cold day", a detective is the protagonist with a double and ambiguous role, which forces the viewer to construct hypotheses such as that the detective is dreaming, sitting in his chair in front of his fireplace or remembering or thinking about what I would like to have done, or even other hypotheses that lead to possible readings for understanding the plot. Another short film that depends on the viewer is "Chatter" (Max Kozik), where the protagonist is a young man who tries to understand the endless speeches of his colleagues until he meets a young deaf mute who catches his attention and who demands an effort to write and adapt to your silent world. After hits and misses, both remain focused on making themselves understood. Always relying on a spectator who shares the challenges presented, the short "Chatter" dialogues with "Les chaussures de Louis" (Théo Jamin), who demands that the spectator get to know the world of an autistic person helped by his teacher who, in order for student has interaction with the class, asks them to share the understanding that the autistic person presents. Using shoes as metonyms, the short is reflective, displaying, in a few minutes, a vision of the different life of autism, as well as the different life of the deaf and dumb. The short "One night stand", by Azalia Muchransyah, requires an intercultural repertoire. The spectator must understand that the word 'nightstand' in English has a double meaning, it is the bedside table as well as the relationship of a night. The bedside table is the narrator of the short film, which tells the adventures of its owner in his nightstands and suggests changes in behavior, acting in the successful dream. If the viewer does not understand the game with words, the short film loses part of its relevance, despite its artistic construction. Regarding the viewer, the short film that most captures their attention and demands their concentration is "Dormo poco e sogno molto" (Paolo Santamaria), a fast-paced sequence shot, with a soundtrack that follows the movement of mobile phones and tablets that move and lead the gaze of the spectator, who must also read the subtitles if he doesn't understand Italian. The short is an exercise in attentive observation to capture in four minutes an entire non-traditional way of life, described in an innovative way, drawing on a travel philosophy. The viewer in this case must be an interactor who can share and understand the protagonist's idea. In the five short films, placed here in convergent dialogues, we can note that the viewer, no longer passive, must become increasingly active until reaching the last one, which is a real challenge both in editing and in speed, in the soundtrack and in the idea conductive.

## CONVERGING DIALOGUES IV

There are four short films that converge on the theme of depression. The protagonist of "Mother didn't know", short by Anita Killi, receives help from a fairy tale character to get out of the metaphorical place in which she finds herself, isolated as if she were in a deep well. When she sees a bird that needs her help, she comes out of her isolation and, seeing it flying, alive, she also decides, as in a fable, to return to her life, calling for her mother. With impressionist aesthetics to portray the nihilism of the character, the short film "Down", by Gabriella Muresán, talks with the short film by Anita Killi, in the sense of the protagonist's trajectory, which reaches the depths of her self, tormented by her lack of reaction, accepting being worthless, until the moment she resolves to react to depression alone, struggling to become free from her apathy. The short "Wot If", by Monami Roy, inspired by the poem "what if", by Shel Silverstein, describes the trajectory of a girl with an anxiety problem, who asks herself "wot if", or what if – how about if I'm being refused by everyone, how about if my parents abandon me and my colleagues laugh at me and don't accept me, until the moment I decide to face their challenges and become strong to survive their fears in dialogue with the short film "Down". Valeria Rodriguez's short "Liebenstraum" begins Nietzschean, in a dark tone, with a character who, unlike the protagonist girl who comes out of depression to save the bird, does not call the injured person for an ambulance and puts another date in her suicide letter , contemplating his revolver. However, when falling asleep, his memories refer to the free will mentioned by his mother, and those who decide to hurt others and the images that follow are of wars, bombs and deaths, until the moment when his memory evokes his mother again, when it says that free will can create art and images follow one another, to the sound of Liebenstraum no. 3 by Franz Liszt. Inspired by Fyodor Dostoyevski's "El sueño de um hombre ridiculous", the short develops a dialogue with the image of the mother, evoked by the girl in the first short of this part of the convergent dialogues and also by the character of this short film, following a path that unites beginning and end of this circular analysis.

## CONVERGING DIALOGUES V

This series of 3 shorts features a converging theme: desires. However, views and perspectives differ. In "The Dead Hands of Dublin", by Leo Crowley, the main pianist projects his fame and his power in the use of magic gloves that make him perform classic pieces with mastery. However, over time, his desires for greatness lead him to exercise his tyranny. The short evokes the fascination for fame that makes good intentions lead to crooked paths. The "Web" protagonist's desire, on the other hand, is to get off the Internet. The short dialogues with Sherry Turkle's research, when she is fascinated by social media in her first texts, but little by little realizes that the crowd is dispersive. His book *Alone Together* can be adapted to dialogue with the protagonist when she has only one desire: to leave the net. "Kiwi's Dream", by Paloma Zhu, expresses the desire of animals made of origami that want to leave their places, want to be real, want to interact, fly and live, impossible situations to be realized, and that dialogue with the short "Mama", where a boy wishes to have his deceased mother back. Her dad says she's on a star and he goes to a magic shop, buys a bow and brings his star to her bedside. In both shorts, wishes are impossible. The desire of the protagonist of Ralph Khoury's short, "I want to leave", is one of hope and hopelessness, it is a desire for radical change, almost asking for a miracle, for a life with other goals, with peace. The aesthetic is minimalist, the montage swings like a pendulum, sometimes revealing the protagonist's willingness to change, sometimes returning to the routine of the status quo. A short that manages, in a few minutes, to contemplate deep and complex facets that frustrate expectations of change.

To close these Convergent Dialogues, I quote the short "Animators for Belarus / Long live Belarus", by 50 animators from 19 countries, with a geometric aesthetic with an emphasis on a red stripe where there are birds in their flights, tanks, weeping eyes, flowers that ask for peace and, relevant to our ANIMATIBA, a lizard that draws a beating heart.

Assim, sete encontros foram realizados, no formato de lives, transmitidas pela plataforma ANIMATIBA PLAY ([play.animatiba.com.br](http://play.animatiba.com.br)) e pelo CANAL ANIMATIBA do Youtube (<https://www.youtube.com/user/ANIMATIBA>). Os vídeos do Canal Animatiba ficarão disponíveis para futuras visualizações, uma vez que as lives se constituem em importantes documentos das ideias trocadas, de interesse de estudantes, pesquisadores, profissionais e público em geral.



## DIA 01 – 20 HORAS – LIVE 01 – ABERTURA

O festival teve sua abertura oficial através de uma live com os três organizadores do evento e os cinco jurados do festival, respectivamente DENIZE ARAUJO, DANIELLA MICHELENA, PAULO MUNHOZ, HONG SUK HWA, ROSANA URBES, ELIS LOBO, RICARDO ROMIN E VALU VASCONCELOS. Paulo Munhoz fez a abertura oficial, agradecendo os incentivadores e apoiadores.

Desenvolveu-se a seguir uma estimulante conversa sobre o cinema de animação, séries de animação e a articulação da animação com os games. Discutiu-se a alta qualidade dos trabalhos, a grande diversidade técnica e narrativa, as principais temáticas. Conversou-se sobre os filmes brasileiros e os filmes estudantis brasileiros, observando a alta qualidade técnica nacional, pari passu com o conteúdo estrangeiro. Denize Araújo estabeleceu relações de alguns filmes com o “olho” do ANIMATIBA. Paulo Munhoz falou dos aspectos simbólicos do festival, como o mascote Garti, e apontou o grande desafio na construção de uma plataforma de streaming exclusiva para o evento, destacando o trabalho do cientista da computação Guilmour Rossi.

Rosana Urbes contou sobre sua experiência como artista premiada no primeiro ANIMATIBA e o impacto ao receber o troféu ANIMATIBOSCÓPIO. Os jurados foram unânimes em relatar a riqueza dos filmes selecionados e a experiência complexa de elencar os melhores entre filmes tão bons. Houve também uma conversa aprofundada sobre as relações pessoais de cada um com a arte da animação. O jurado Hong Suk Hwa precisou sair um pouco antes do final da conversa, para levar seus filhos à escola (lá na Coreia do Sul eram 8:30 da manhã) o que deu um toque mágico a uma conversa que já era muito estimulante.



## DIA 03 – 20 HORAS – LIVE 02 – ANIMAÇÃO CURITIBANA E PARANAENSE

O segundo encontro do evento reuniu os produtores locais FELIPE GROSSO (CABONG STUDIOS), WALKIR FERNANDES (DOGZILLA), FERNANDO MACEDO (SPIRIT) e PAULO MUNHOZ (TECNOKENA/ANIMATIBA) numa conversa com JUSSARA LOCATELLI, presidente do SIAPAR – SINDICATO DA INDÚSTRIA AUDIOVISUAL DO PARANÁ e WILLIAM BAGIOLI, vice-presidente da AVEC – ASSOCIAÇÃO DE VIDEO E CINEMA DO PARANÁ.

Cada representante falou da sua empresa ou instituição, abordou aspectos históricos de sua constituição, apresentou seu ponto de vista sobre os desafios e oportunidades da indústria e estabeleceu uma reflexão sobre o papel que Curitiba já desempenha no setor e o quanto pode crescer no mercado nacional e internacional de animação. Um fator citado várias vezes foi o caráter de progressão geracional pelo reconhecimento de uma escada, onde o estagiário de ontem é o empresário de hoje, demonstrando um círculo virtuoso de produção, formação, empreendedorismo.

Ficou patente o grande montante que as empresas de animação curitibana trazem para a cidade em termos de investimentos federais (um total acumulado superior a R\$ 20 milhões só do FSA – Fundo Setorial do Audiovisual e Lei do Audiovisual), prestação de serviços para outros estados e países, bem como sua importância como geradoras de empregos, renda, tributos e novos negócios. Os três estúdios convidados para o encontro empregam em 2021 cem pessoas, em tempo integral, de forma contínua.

Ficou clara também a falta de uma política específica para o setor da animação. Jussara Locatelli estimulou a todos para a participação nas entidades de forma a que se possa dar andamento a proposições de ordem política.



Seus filmes foram exibidos e premiados em alguns festivais nacionais e também exibidos internacionalmente. Desde 2014 é pai do Santiago.

FERNANDO MACEDO – Produtor, diretor, roteirista, CCO e fundador da SPIRIT Animation Studios.

WALKIR FERNANDES – Produtor de animação, sócio-diretor na Dogzilla Studio, onde produz e dirige projetos de animação para TV e cinema. Entre seus últimos trabalhos, destaque para a animação Apneia, premiada como Melhor Filme no 47º Festival de Gramado, Melhor filme pela crítica no 27º Animamundi e finalista no Grande Prêmio do Cinema Brasileiro.

FELIPE GROSSO – Formado em Design Gráfico, é Produtor de Animação, sócio-diretor da Cabong Studios. Recebeu diversos prêmios de financiamento, com destaque para a Série Planetorama e dois Prêmios de Núcleos Criativos apoiados por ANCINE-FSA-BRDE.

## DIA 06 – 20 HORAS – LIVE 03 – SÉRIES EM ANIMAÇÃO.

O terceiro encontro do ANIMATIBA tratou de séries de televisão. Como convidados, dois craques, Hygor Amorin (OZ PRODUTORA) e Jonas Brandão (SPLIT STUDIO), contaram suas experiências e falaram dos seus conteúdos bem-sucedidos, com destaque para as séries de TV MYTIKAH, WeeBoom e Turma da Mônica.

O encontro permitiu um aprofundamento do público a respeito de como se desenvolve uma série, como se cria uma bíblia de apresentação e uma bíblia de produção de qualidade, dicas para um bom storytelling, como se desenvolvem personagens e como se determina o modo de animar. Além disso, os convidados também expuseram suas estratégias de venda e financiamento de suas produções.

Além disso, os convidados também filosofaram sobre as relações entre produzir conteúdos infantis, sendo pais, ou seja, convivendo com a crítica do público dentro de casa.

Falou-se também do momento por que passa o audiovisual brasileiro, sem editais de fomento e sem clareza dos rumos futuros. Destacou-se a necessidade do financiamento de séries brasileiras com várias temporadas de forma que as mesmas possam alcançar o mercado internacional e se tornar efetivamente rentáveis, consolidando um retorno de 100% ou mais ao Fundo Setorial e gerando novos negócios.



## DIA 10 – 21:30 HORAS – LIVE 05 – PREMIAÇÃO

O momento mais empolgante de um festival de cinema sempre é a premiação. O público lota o espaço na torcida pelos seus filmes preferidos, os cineastas e suas equipes estão nervosos e a cada anúncio os corações disparam, alguns pela extrema e ansiada alegria, outros pela inevitável tristeza. Todavia, neste ano não havia como termos esse tipo de envolvimento direto, de forma que utilizamos uma live para o anúncio dos prêmios. Compensamos a menor emoção com uma pequena análise de cada obra premiada. Além disso, ao invés de fazer a premiação no último dia do festival, fizemos-la no dia dez de setembro, permitindo ao público a degustação dos premiados por mais alguns dias.

Participaram da noite de premiação os diretores do festival, bem como os jurados. O público pôde acompanhar pela plataforma ANIMATIBA PLAY e pelo Canal do Youtube.

Todos os jurados comentaram sobre a dificuldade de escolher melhores filmes entre obras de tão alta qualidade e a clara injustiça que se comete quando se tem que optar entre dois filmes de igual patamar artístico. Entretanto, essa é a regra do jogo e não se pode fugir ao regulamento.

O Júri criou dois prêmios especiais, o PRÊMIO ESPECIAL DO JÚRI para o filme ALMIRANTE NEGRO, de Anderson Cruz, e o PRÊMIO ESPECIAL DO JÚRI PARA O MELHOR FILME SOBRE A PANDEMIA, no entendimento de que esse evento histórico, tratado em diversas obras, precisava estar marcado indelevelmente no processo meritório do festival, como que num esforço para derrotar a pandemia Covid-19 enquadrando-a sob o olhar bem-humorado de JUAN PABLO ZARAMELLA, em seu filme INT NOCHE.



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## DIA 13 – 20 HORAS – LIVE 06 – ENCONTRO ACADÊMICO

ANIMATIBA já nasceu com a vocação de construir pontes entre o setor produtivo, escolas, instituições diversas e Universidades. Por isso realizamos um encontro para o qual foram convidados professores de diversas instituições de ensino a fim de trocarem informações e visões sobre os melhores caminhos da formação profissional e da pesquisa em animação.

Sob a direção de DANIELLA MICHELENA, Diretora Acadêmica do Festival e também professora do Curso de Design da Universidade Federal do Paraná, participaram do debate AZALIA MUCHRANSYAH, Produtora de Animação e Coordenadora de Conteúdo do Programa de Cinema da Escola de Design da Bina Nusantara University da Indonesia; ELIS LOBO, pesquisadora de Animação e docente do Programa de Design da Universidade Tecnológica Federal do Paraná; DENIZE ARAUJO, Curadora Presidente do Festival e Coordenadora da Pós em Cinema da Universidade Tuiuti do Paraná; REYNALDO MARCHESINI, Produtor de Animação e Representante do Curso de Pós-graduação em Produção Executiva em Animação das Faculdades Méliès.

A conversa principiou pelas apresentações pessoais e pela apresentação do panorama local por DANIELLA e nacional pela ELIS, o que demonstrou as demandas e as possibilidades de formação acadêmica e profissional em animação. Cada participante expôs sua experiência pessoal e seus pontos de vista, numa troca muito rica. DENIZE ARAÚJO se colocou como alguém 100% envolvida com cinema, embora sempre de forma teórica, e afirmou ser importantíssimo buscar uma formação que alie teoria e prática,. MARCHESINI apresentou um raio-x das produtoras brasileiras e os gargalos que as mesmas enfrentam, sendo um deles a qualidade da mão-de-obra e a expertise em administração. AZALIA MUCHRANSYAH descreveu sua trajetória desde sua formação na Universidade de Buffalo, nos Estados Unidos até a sua atividade atual como professora e realizadora. A troca de percepções continuou bastante animada e sua riqueza pode ser encontrada no canal ANIMATIBA do Youtube.



Em 2004, foi responsável pela coprodução internacional da série animada brasileira "Sea Princesses", (104 episódios) distribuída em 128 países. Reynaldo participa ativamente, há muitos anos, do desenvolvimento de Projetos e laboratórios de pitching desenvolvidos em todo o Brasil como Anima Mundi, Rio2C, AnimaTV, Programas estaduais de desenvolvimento de Animação e no exterior, no programa SEA do Animation Workshop (Dinamarca), tendo avaliado ou prestado consultoria em mais de 300 projetos de animação. Foi produtor executivo e supervisor artístico na série animada do "Sítio do Picapau Amarelo" – a primeira coprodução de animação da TV Globo e Mixer, em exibição também pelo Cartoon Network.



## DIA 15 – 19 HORAS – LIVE 07 – ENCERRAMENTO

Estiveram presentes JUAN PABLO ZARAMELLA, do filme INT NOCHE, da Argentina; ANDERSON CRUZ, do filme ALMIRANTE NEGRO, do Rio de Janeiro; MARCOS MAGALHÃES, também do Rio, diretor de AS NOVAS AVENTURAS DO KAISER; ANITA KILLI, do filme MOTHER DIDN'T KNOW, da Noruega; BÉLA KLINGL, do filme BOXI AND THE LOST TREASURE, da Hungria; ÁLVARO CÁCERES, do filme MISIÓN H2O, da Venezuela; GABRIEL VERDUGO SOTO, do filme ELULU, do Chile; ATISH TRIPATHI, do filme CAPTAIN VIDYUT, da Índia. Como anfitriões, Paulo Munhoz, Valu Vasconcelos, Rosana Urbes e Ricardo Romin.

O encontro aconteceu em 3 atos, o primeiro de apresentação de cada um e de seu trabalho, o segundo mais livre, de questionamentos e trocas de impressões, o terceiro de agradecimentos e parabéns a todos os envolvidos com o festival. Desde os iniciantes como Gabriel Soto, extasiado com o prêmio para um filme que tomou 8 anos de sua vida, até astros veteranos como Juan Pablo Zaramella (ganhador de Óscar e presente no Guiness Book como tendo o filme mais premiado do mundo), as expressões foram todas de alegria e contentamento para com o ANIMATIBA. Alguns, como Álvaro Cáceres, destacaram a dificuldade em se fazer um longa-metragem em meio a dificuldades econômicas, outros divagaram sobre a lida poética específica da animação, outros testemunharam, como Marcos Magalhães, uma vida dedicada a essa arte. Todos parabenizaram a organização e nos desejaram vida longa e próspera. A reunião ocorreu de forma trilíngue, em português, inglês e espanhol. Assim, vencendo barreiras de fuso, de língua e de ordem técnica, nosso festival cumpriu sua missão de unir pessoas de nações distantes, na expectativa da construção de um mundo melhor.




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## MEETINGS – LIVES

The pandemic did not prevent the exhibition of films nor the ANIMATIBA meetings, which are fundamental for reflecting on the state of the art of global animation, as well as discussing the problems of the Brazilian audiovisual sector and listing strategies for the sector's growth. Thus, seven meetings were held, in the format of lives, broadcast by the ANIMATIBA PLAY platform ([play.animatiba.com.br](http://play.animatiba.com.br)) and by the ANIMATIBA YouTube channel (<https://www.youtube.com/user/ANIMATIBA>). The videos in Animatiba Channel will be available for future viewing, since the lives are important documents of the ideas exchanged, of interest to students, researchers, professionals and the general public.



## DAY 01 – 20 H (BRT) – LIVE 01 – OPENING

The festival had its official opening through a live with the three event organizers and the five festival judges, respectively DENIZE ARAUJO, DANIELLA MICHELENA, PAULO MUNHOZ, HONG SUK HWA, ROSANA URBES, ELIS LOBO, RICARDO ROMIN and VALU VASCONCELOS. Paulo Munhoz made the official opening, thanking the supporters and supporters.

A stimulating conversation about animation cinema, animation series and the articulation of animation with games was then developed. The high quality of the works, the great technical and narrative diversity, the main themes were discussed. They talked about Brazilian films and Brazilian student films, observing the high national technical quality, pari passu with foreign content. Denize Araújo established relationships between some films and the “eye” of ANIMATIBA. Paulo Munhoz spoke about the symbolic aspects of the festival, such as the mascot Garti, and pointed out the great challenge in building an exclusive streaming platform for the event, highlighting the work of computer scientist Guilmour Rossi.

Rosana Urbes told about her experience as an artist awarded at the first ANIMATIBA and the impact of receiving the ANIMATIBOSCÓPIO trophy. The judges were unanimous in reporting the richness of the selected films and the complex experience of listing the best among such good films. There was also an in-depth conversation about each other's personal relationships with the art of animation. The judge Hong Suk Hwa had to leave a little before the end of the conversation, to take his children to school (in South Korea it was 8:30 am) which gave a magical touch to an already very stimulating conversation.



## DAY 03 – 20 H (BRT) – LIVE 02 – CURITIBA'S ANIMATION

The second meeting of the event brought together the local producers FELIPE GROSSO (CABONG STUDIOS), WALKIR FERNANDES (DOGZILLA), FERNANDO MACEDO (SPIRIT) and PAULO MUNHOZ (TECNOKENA/ANIMATIBA) in a conversation with JUSSARA LOCATELLI, president of SIAPAR – SINDICATO DA INDÚSTRIA AUDIOVISUAL DO PARANÁ and WILLIAM BAGIOLI, vice president of AVEC – ASSOCIAÇÃO DE VIDEO E CINEMA DO PARANÁ.

Each representative spoke about their company or institution, discussed historical aspects of its constitution, presented their point of view on the challenges and opportunities of the industry and established a reflection on the role that Curitiba already plays in the sector and how much it can grow in the national market and international animation. A factor mentioned several times was the character of generational progression through the recognition of a ladder, where yesterday's pupil is today's entrepreneur, demonstrating a virtuous circle of production, training, entrepreneurship.

It was clear the large amount that Curitiba animation companies bring to the city in terms of federal investments (a cumulative total of more than R\$ 20 million from the FSA – Audiovisual Sector Fund and Audiovisual Law alone) providing services to other states and countries, as well as their importance as generators of jobs, income, taxes and new businesses. In 2021, the three studios invited to the meeting employ one hundred people, full-time, on a continuous basis.

The lack of a specific policy for the animation sector was also clear. Jussara Locatelli encouraged everyone to participate in the entities so that political proposals could be carried out.

JUSSARA LOCATELLI – Curitiban, CEO of Realiza Vídeo, a content producer that has been in the market for 30 years, where she produced and directed over a hundred documentary videos, TV programs and corporate institutional. President of the Union of Audiovisual Industry of the State of Paraná – SIAPAR . Director of FAMES – Audiovisual Forum Minas, Espírito Santo and Southern States – Paraná, Santa Catarina and Rio Grande do Sul. Representative of the State of Paraná at BRAVI – Brasil Audiovisual Independente

WILLIAM BAGIOLI – Film club organizer, programmer, screenwriter and director residing in Curitiba, Paraná. He scripted and directed the short films Curitiba: the biggest and best city in the world, O Parking, and co-directed the short film Duda with Eugenia Castello, in addition to signing the script for the feature film Mirador by Bruno Costa. His films were shown and awarded in some national festivals and also shown internationally. Since 2014 he has been Santiago's father.

FERNANDO MACEDO – Producer, director, screenwriter, CCO and founder of SPIRIT Animation Studios.

WALKIR FERNANDES – Animation producer, managing partner at Dogzilla Studio, where he produces and directs animation projects for TV and cinema. Among his last works, highlight for the animation Apneia, awarded as Best Film at the 47th Gramado Festival, Best film by critics at the 27th Animamundi and finalist at the Grand Prix of Brazilian Cinema

FELIPE GROSSO – Graduated in Graphic Design, he is an Animation Producer, partner-director at Cabong Studios. He has received several funding awards, notably the Planetorama Series and two Creative Core Awards supported by ANCINE-FSA-BRDE.

## DAY 06 – 20 H (BRT) – LIVE 03 – ANIMATION SERIES.

ANIMATIBA's third meeting dealt with television series. As guests, two star players, Hygor Amorim (OZ PRODUCER) and Jonas Brandão (SPLIT STUDIO), shared their experiences and talked about their successful content, highlighting the TV series MYTIKAH, WeeBoom and Turma da Mônica.

The meeting allowed the audience to go deeper into how a series is developed, how a presentation bible and a quality production bible are created, tips for good storytelling, how characters are developed and how to determine the way to animate. In addition, guests also exposed their sales and financing strategies for their productions.

In addition, the guests also philosophized about the relationship between producing children's content, being parents, that is, living with the public's criticism at home.

There was also talk of the moment the Brazilian audiovisual is going through, with no promotional notices and no clarity of future directions. The need to finance Brazilian series with several seasons was highlighted, so that they can reach the international market and become effectively profitable, consolidating a return of 100% or more to the Sectorial Fund and generating new business.



Graduated in Image and Sound from UFSCAR and having worked for the National Film Board of Canada, Jonas is one of the founders of Split Studio. Through Split, Jonas has directed and produced dozens of works, including games, music videos, short films, commercials and series. Among his most recent works are the series 'WeeBoom' and 'Turma da Mônica', in which he was director and screenwriter.

HYGOR AMORIN – Father of Cisco, founder and CEO at OZ PRODUCER, filmmaker, curious, lover of new technologies and entrepreneur since ever. He believes that audiovisual can change the world.

## DAY 08 – 20 H (BRT) – LIVE 04 – ANIMATION NATIONAL MEETING

Another important Live was the NATIONAL ANIMATION MEETING, bringing together the two main entities representing the sector. ABCA – Brazilian Association of Animation Cinema is the institution that represents animation professionals, while ABRANIMA – Brazilian Animation Association is the entity that represents the animation production companies for TV, Cinema, Internet and Games. In addition to these two entities, the FORUM de ANIMAÇÃO was also present, an event aimed at bringing together Brazil and Portugal for the co-production and distribution of animation content.

Valu Vasconcelos, the festival's judge, also represented ABRANIMA as the entity's director, replacing Alexandre Machado, who was hospitalized. Raquel Fukuda represented ABCA and João Apolinário Mendes represented the Forum.

The entities introduced themselves, the difficult moment of the Brazilian audiovisual industry was analyzed, with ANCINE blocked in the dialogue with the productive sector and apparently locked in its functioning. Paulo Munhoz commented on his research on development and regulation, in which he had the support of the eminent Dr. Manoel Camargo, postdoctoral fellow in Administrative Law whose vision demonstrates that the problem of ANCINE is not only circumstantial, but stems from an inadequate institutional formulation since its birth, so that the many achievements obtained over time become fragile in view of the model adopted.

ABRANIMA presented data on the economic strength of the sector and how much remains to reach its full potential. ABCA highlighted the qualitative growth of Brazilian production and the challenges faced by animators. João Mendes brought data from Portuguese and European production and urged everyone to participate in FORUM in October. Over time, the event brought the entities closer together, so that a bridge was established towards future joint work on several fronts. Thus, ANIMATIBA fulfilled its role of strengthening ties and organizing efforts for animation.

He curated "Tudo Bom" for the Annecy International Festival (year in which Brazil was honored) Directed, produced and animated the authorial short film "Péssima Ideia, Ernesto"., Maurício de Souza Produções, Otto Guerra, O2 Filmes, Papel de Papel, Farofa Studios, Boutique Filmes and Birdo Studio, where he coordinated the production of the series of Olympic mascots "Vinicius and Tom: entertaining by nature" (Cartoon Network), "Oswaldo" (Cartoon Network, TV Cultura and Disney), "Cupcake and Dinosaur" (Netflix and Disney) and "Clube da Anittinha" (Gloob). Since 2011 coordinates the animation festival FILE Anima+. Director of ABCA – Associação Brasileira de Cinema de Animation.

**JOÃO APOLINÁRIO MENDES** – Director and creator of the animation film festival OLHO and one of the organizers of the Animation Forum. He has a Masters in Computer Animation and a degree in Sound and Image from Universidade Católica do Porto. He is a professor of animation film at Escola Artística Soares dos Reis. He collaborated with the companies Teatro de Puppets do Porto and Red Cloud Puppets where he participated in five plays exploring the relationship between puppetry and animation film. He was co-director of the animated short film "O Alma Grande". He co-founded the audiovisual production company Husma, active between 2010 and 2014. Coordinator of the FORUM DE ANIMAÇÃO event.

## DAY 10 – 21:30 H (BRT) – LIVE 05 – AWARDS

The most exciting moment of a film festival is always the awards. The public fills the space in the cheering section for their favorite films, the filmmakers and their teams are nervous and with each announcement their hearts race, some with the extreme and longed-for joy, others with the inevitable sadness. However, this year there was no way we could have this kind of direct involvement, so we used a live to announce the awards. We compensate for the slightest emotion by a small analysis of each awarded work. Furthermore, instead of awarding on the last day of the festival, we did it on September 10th, allowing the public to taste the winners for a few more days.

The festival directors as well as the judges participated in the awards night. The public can follow the ANIMATIBA PLAY platform and the Youtube Channel.

All the judges commented on the difficulty of choosing the best films among works of such high quality and the clear injustice that is done when you have to choose between two films of equal artistic level. However, this is the rule of the game and you cannot escape the regulations.

The Jury created two special awards, the SPECIAL JURY AWARD for the film ALMIRANTE NEGRO, by Anderson Cruz, and the SPECIAL JURY AWARD FOR THE BEST FILM ABOUT THE PANDEMIC, on the understanding that this historic event, treated in several works, it needed to be indelibly imprinted on the festival's meritorious process, as if in an effort to defeat the Covid-19 pandemic by framing it under the good-humored gaze of JUAN PABLO ZAREMELLA, in his film INT NOCHE.

## **DAY 13 – 20 H (BRT) – LIVE 06 – ACADEMIC MEETING**

ANIMATIBA was born with the vocation to build bridges between the productive sector, schools, various institutions and universities. That's why we held a meeting to which professors from various educational institutions were invited to exchange information and views on the best paths for professional training and research in animation.

Under the direction of DANIELLA MICHELENA, Academic Director of the Festival and also professor of the Design Course at the Universidade Federal do Paraná, participated in the debate AZALIA MUCHRANSYAH, Animation Producer and Content Coordinator of the Film Program at the Bina Nusantara University School of Design at Indonesia; ELIS LOBO, Animation researcher and professor of the Design Program at the Universidade Tecnológica Federal do Paraná; DENIZE ARAUJO, President Curator of the Festival and Coordinator of Post in Cinema at Universidade Tuiuti do Paraná; REYNALDO MARCHESINI, Animation Producer and Representative of the Postgraduate Course in Executive Production in Animation at Faculdades Méliès.

The conversation began with personal presentations and the presentation of the local panorama by DANIELLA and national by ELIS, which demonstrated the demands and possibilities of academic and professional training in animation. Each participant shared their personal experience and points of view, in a very rich exchange. DENIZE ARAÚJO established herself as someone 100% involved in cinema, although always in a theoretical way, and stated that it is very important to seek training that combines theory and practice. MARCHESINI presented an x-ray of Brazilian producers and the bottlenecks they face, one of them being the quality of the workforce and the expertise in administration. AZALIA MUCHRANYAH described her trajectory from her training at the University of Buffalo, in the United States, to her current activity as a teacher and director. The exchange of perceptions continued to be very lively and its richness can be found on ANIMATIBA's YouTube channel.

Azalia Muchransyah – Ph.D. in Media Study from the University at Buffalo, in Buffalo, New York, USA. Filmmaker and teacher of film at Binus University in Indonesia. One of my short animations is going to be screened at ANIMATIBA. I think it will be interesting to talk about the potential of animation in my country and the relation to animation education here. But also to think about how animation itself can be in many forms and it can also be hybrid.

Reynaldo Marchesini – Creative executive producer, artistic supervisor, screenwriter and teacher with over twenty years of professional experience in various areas of entertainment. He was co-owner of companies responsible for the distribution and licensing of international studios in Brazil (Disney, Sony Pictures, Nintendo, ABC, Nelvana, HIT, among others) where he was directly responsible for property licensing programs such as Pokémon, Spider-Man, Caillou, Yu-Gi-Oh!, Strawberry Shortcake, Men in Black and Bananas in Pajamas. In 2004, he was responsible for the international co-production of the Brazilian animated series "Sea Princesses", (104 episodes) distributed in 128 countries. Reynaldo has been actively participating for many years in the development of Projects and pitching laboratories developed throughout Brazil, such as Anima Mundi, Rio2C, AnimaTV, State Animation Development Programs and abroad, in the SEA program of the Animation Workshop (Denmark), having evaluated or consulted on over 300 animation projects. He was executive producer and artistic supervisor on the animated series "Sítio do Picapau Amarelo" – TV Globo and Mixer's first animated co-production, also aired by Cartoon Network.

## Day 15 – 19 H (BRT) – LIVE 07 – CLOSING CELEBRATION

The ANIMATIBA Festival ended with an admirable feat by bringing together, in the same conversation, several directors awarded in this edition. Present were JUAN PABLO ZARAMELLA, from the movie IN NOCHE, from Argentina; ANDERSON CRUZ, from the film ALMIRANTE NEGRO, from Rio de Janeiro; MARCOS MAGALHÃES, also from Rio, director of As Novas Aventuras do Kaiser; ANITA KILLI, from the film Mother Didn't Now, from Norway; BÉLA KLINGL, from the film Boxi and The Lost Treasure, from Hungary; ÁLVARO CÁCERES, from the film Misión H2O, from Venezuela; GABRIEL VERDUGO SOTO, from the film Elulu, from Chile; ATISH TRIPATHI, from the movie Captain Vidyut, India. As hosts, Paulo Munhoz, Valu Vasconcelos, Rosana Urbes and Ricardo Romin.

The meeting took place in 3 acts, the first presenting each person and their work, the second freer, with questions and exchanges of views, the third with thanks and congratulations to everyone involved with the festival.

From beginners like Gabriel Soto, ecstatic over the award for a film that took 8 years of his life, to veteran stars like Juan Pablo Zaramella (Oscar winner and Guinness Book's most awarded film in the world), the expressions were all of joy and contentment towards ANIMATIBA. Some, like Álvaro Cáceres, highlighted the difficulty in making a feature film amid economic difficulties, others rambled on the specific poetic work of animation, others witnessed, like Marcos Magalhães, a life dedicated to this art. Everyone congratulated the organization and wished us a long and prosperous life.

The meeting took place in a trilingual form, in Portuguese, English and Spanish. Thus, overcoming differences in terms of time, language and technical order, our festival fulfilled its mission of uniting people from distant nations, in the hope of building a better world.








## ANIMATORS FOR BELARUS/ LONG LIVE BELARUS



## RESULTADOS

O mapa a seguir é uma compilação dos resultados obtidos pelo festival em termos de visualização on-line ao redor do mundo. Atingimos todos os continentes, com exceção da Oceania. Foi um resultado surpreendente, atingido sem gastos em divulgação pelas redes sociais em outros países. Ou seja, trata-se de uma aderência orgânica do público pela alta qualidade dos filmes e da plataforma construída para o festival. A cidade que mais se manteve conectada foi Curitiba, estando 100% dos 15 dias assistindo aos filmes. As outras cidades e países tiveram conexões randômicas com o festival, em função dos fusos horários e, cremos, pela existência ou não de filmes locais concorrendo. Entre os países mais conectados ao ANIMATIBA pode-se destacar: BRASIL, ESTADOS UNIDOS, VENEZUELA, ESPANHA, ARGENTINA, LETÔNIA, ÍNDIA, COREIA DO SUL e um LOCAL no Oceano Atlântico, perto da ÁFRICA.



Outro resultado importante é de cunho qualitativo. ANIMATIBA apresentou uma mostra impressionante em termos de alto grau técnico e artístico, bem como de profundidade e diversidade de conteúdos. Trata-se de um quesito difícil de mensurar pois não há como prescrutar as mentes daqueles que assistiram a nossos filmes. Importante salientar também o fato de que CURITIBA, através do vídeo de abertura do festival (a cidade como cenário dos personagens animados criados aqui), foi apreciada ao redor do Brasil e no mundo todo. Por fim, o ANIMATIBA estabeleceu laços importantes com profissionais e pesquisadores de outros países, de forma a fortalecer nossa cidade como grande centro produtor e exibidor de cinema e audiovisual em animação.

## RESULTS

The map below is a compilation of the results obtained by the festival in terms of online viewing around the world. We reach all continents, with the exception of Oceania. It was a surprising result achieved even without spending on advertising through social networks in other countries. In other words, it is an organic adhesion of the public for the high quality of the films and the platform built for the festival.

The city that stayed most connected was Curitiba, with 100% of the 15 days watching the movies. The other cities and countries had random connections with the festival, due to time zones and, we believe, due to the existence of local films competing.

Among the countries most connected to ANIMATIBA can be highlighted: BRAZIL; UNITED STATES, VENEZUELA, SPAIN, ARGENTINA, LATVIA, INDIA, SOUTH KOREA and a location on the Atlantic Ocean near AFRICA.



Another important result is qualitative. ANIMATIBA presented excellent films in terms of high technical and artistic degree, as well as depth and diversity of content. This is a difficult item to measure as there is no way to scrutinize the minds of those who have watched our movies.

It is also important to highlight the fact that CURITIBA, through the opening video of the festival (the city as the scenario for the animated characters created here), was appreciated throughout Brazil and around the world.

Finally, ANIMATIBA established important ties with professionals and researchers from other countries, in order to strengthen our city as a great producer and exhibitor of cinema and audiovisual in animation.
